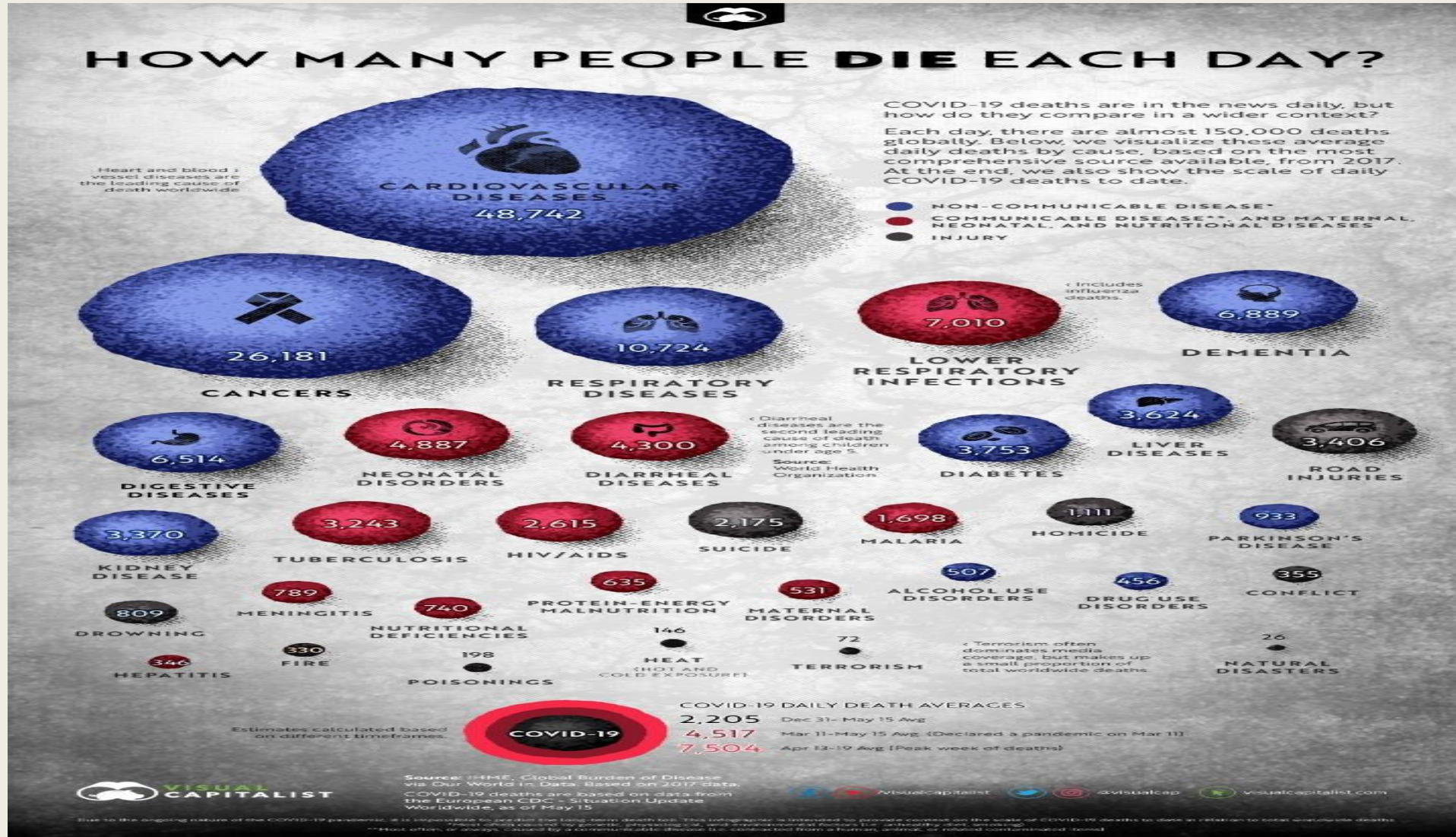
Zoom's Market Capitalization of USD 49 bn is more than that of top 7 airlines combined

5. How Many People Die Each Day

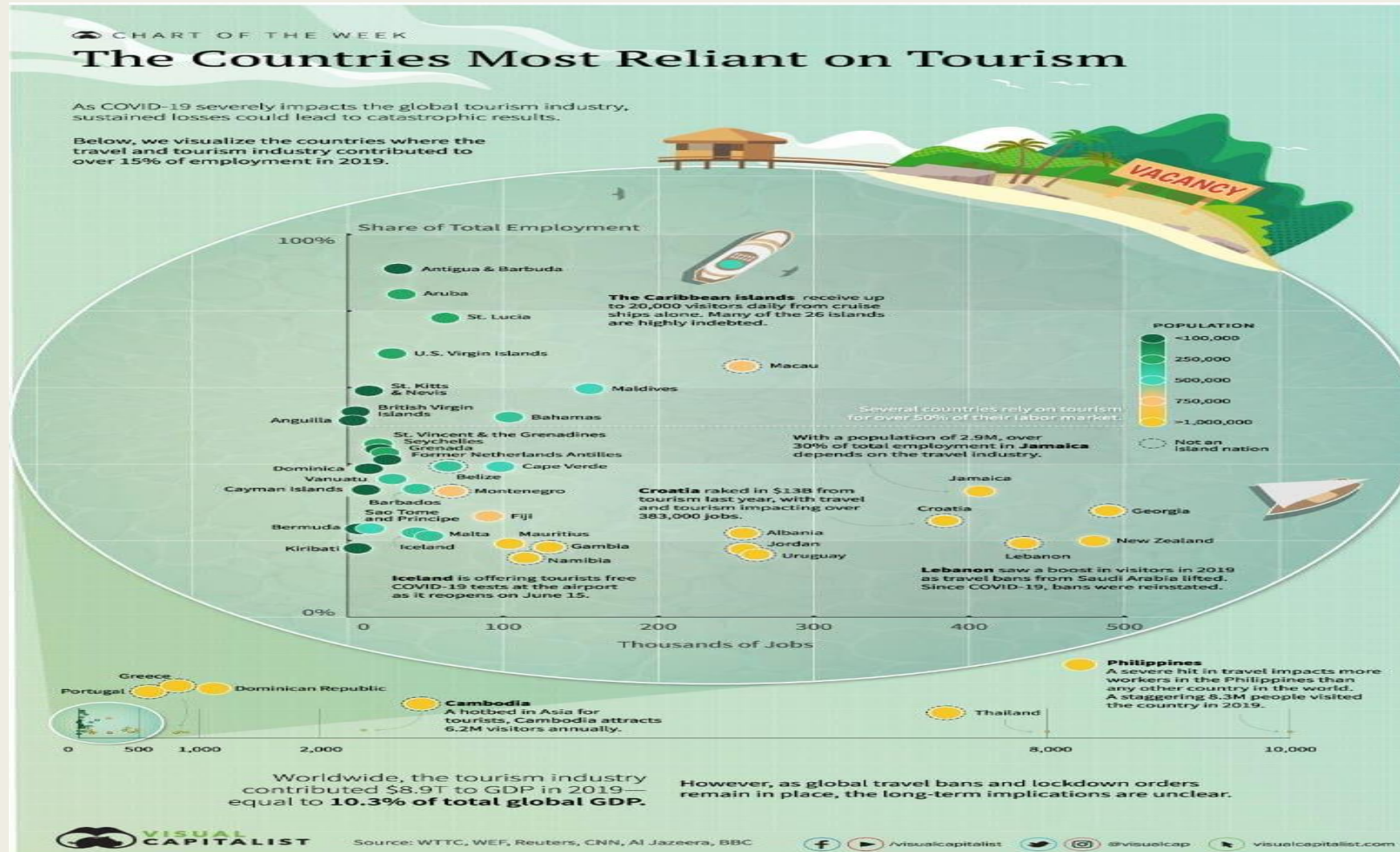
Heart and Blood Vessel diseases are the leading cause of death worldwide

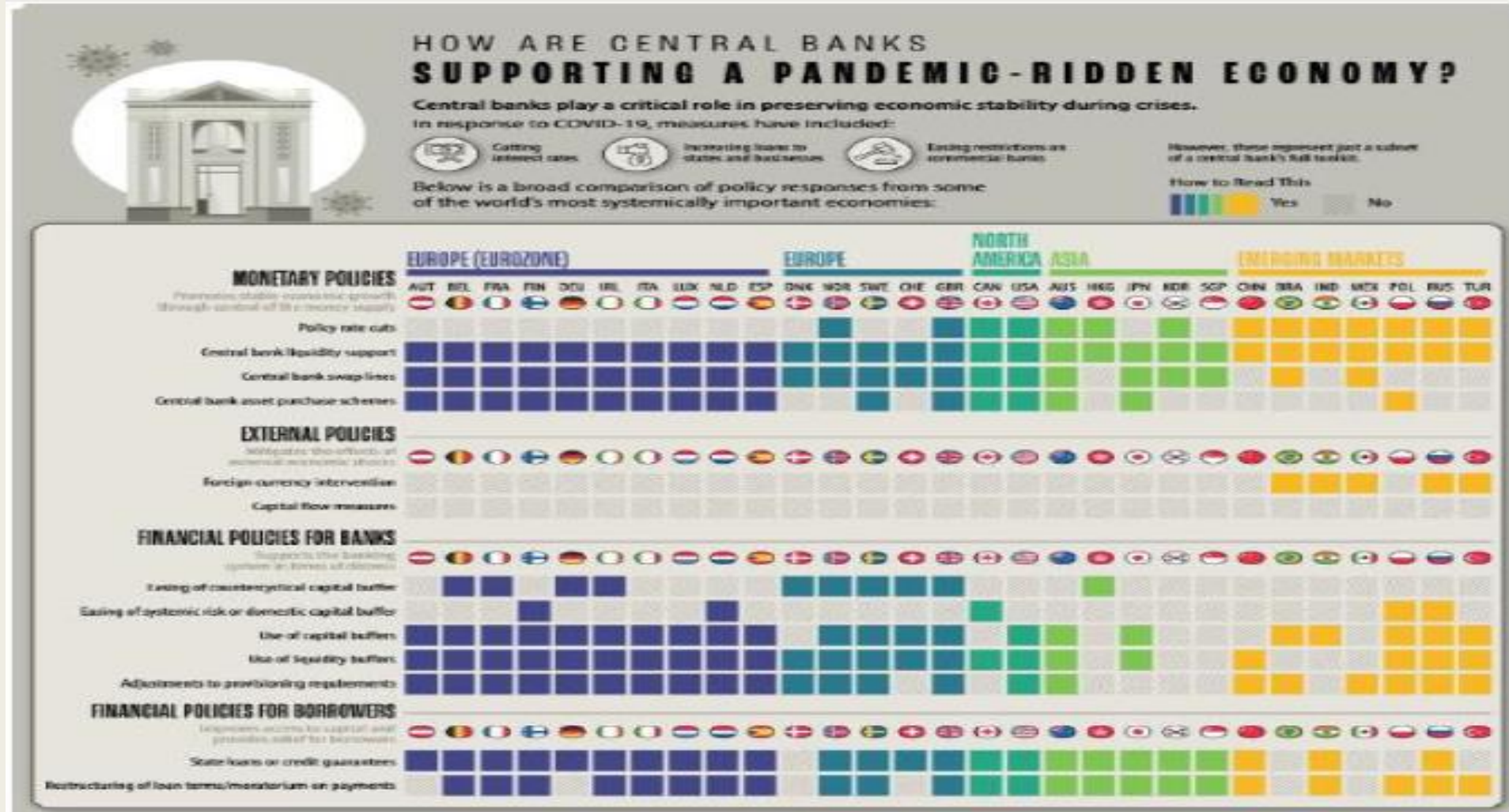
Philippines and Thailand have highest numbers of people employed in Tourism

7. Central Banks in Action

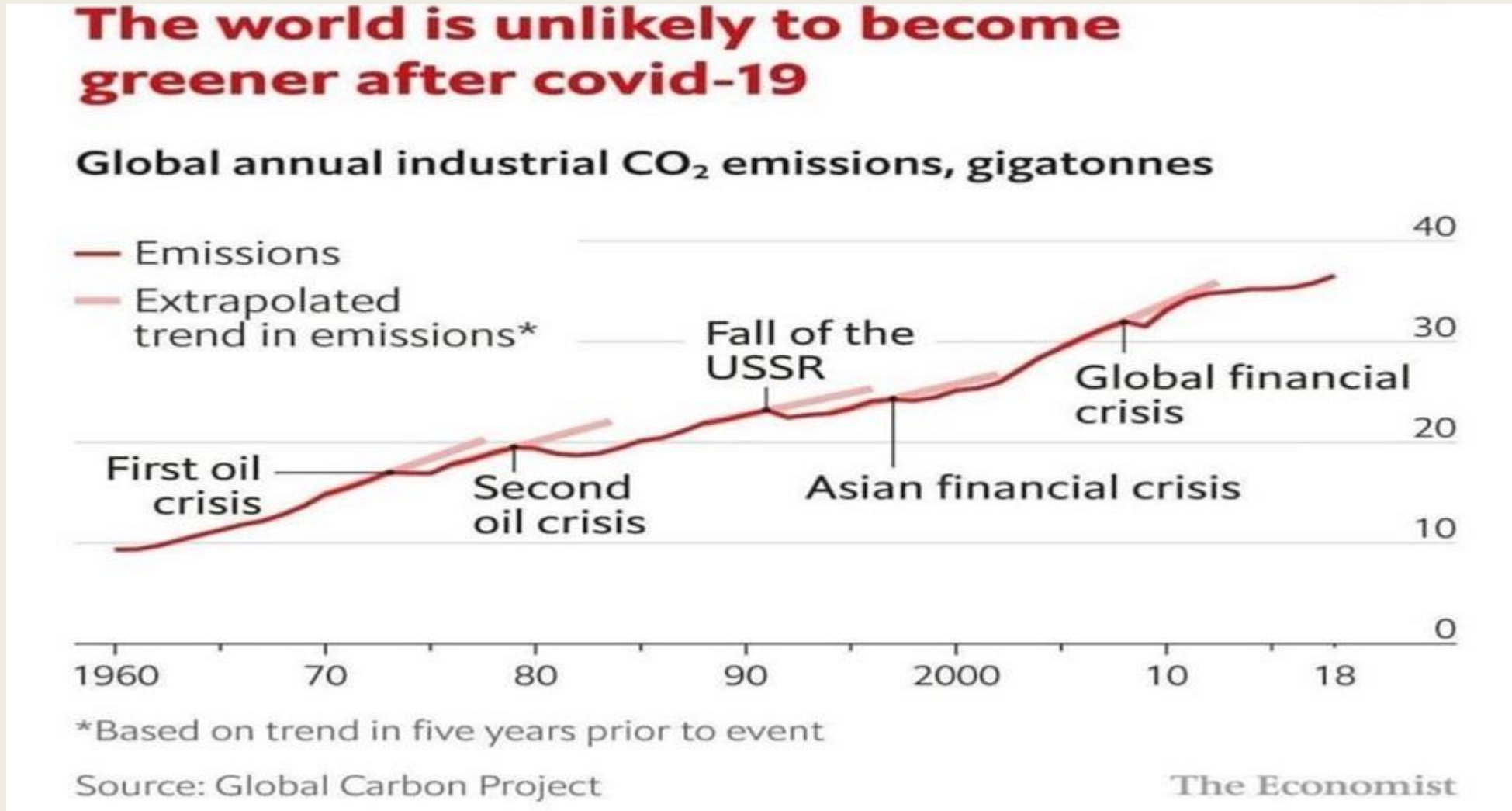
Policy rate cuts and liquidity support have been most common measures in Emerging Markets while Asset Purchase and Swap lines in Europe

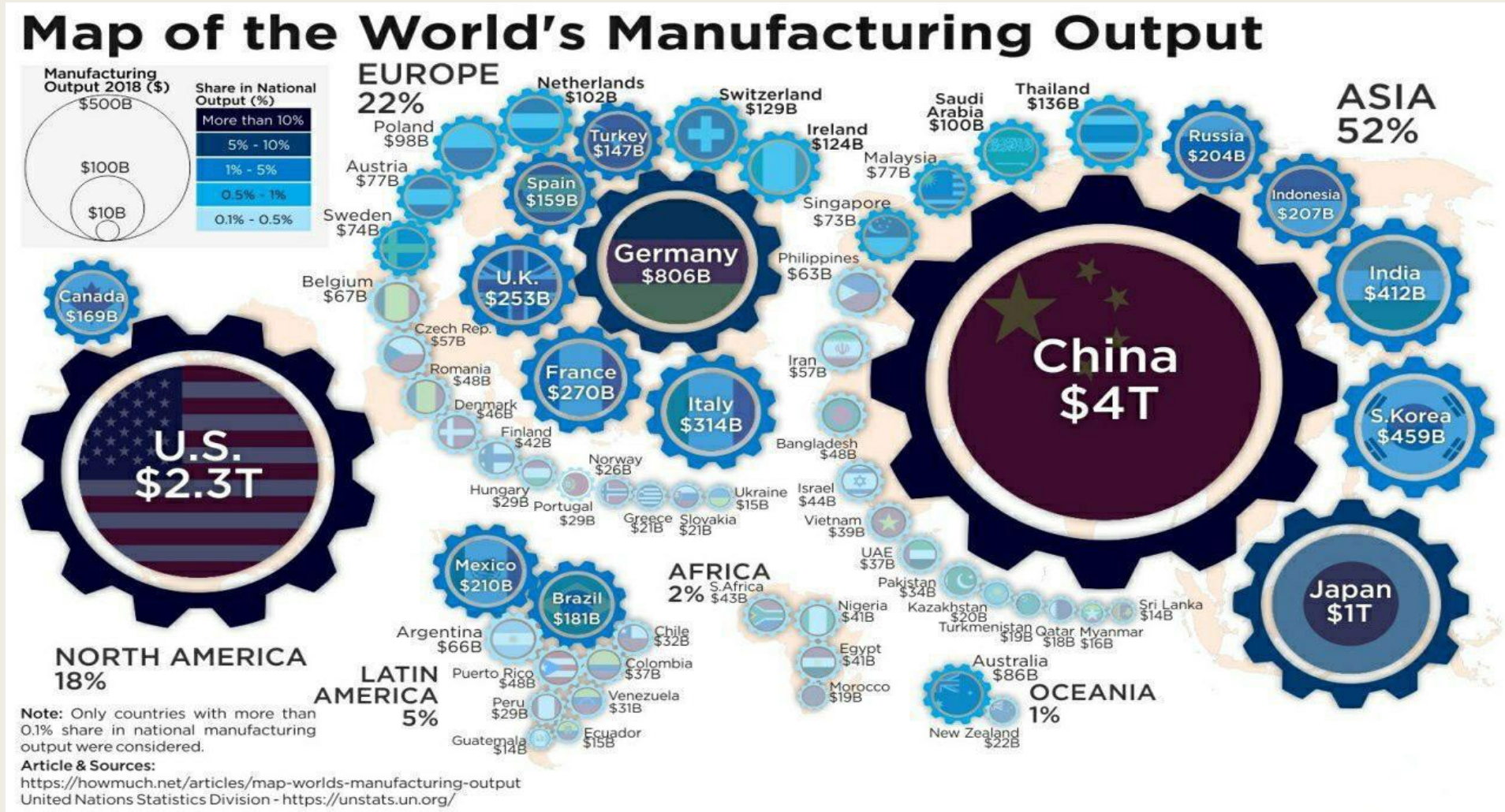
World history shows there is only little difference in actual emissions and trend line after any crisis

9. World's Manufacturing Output

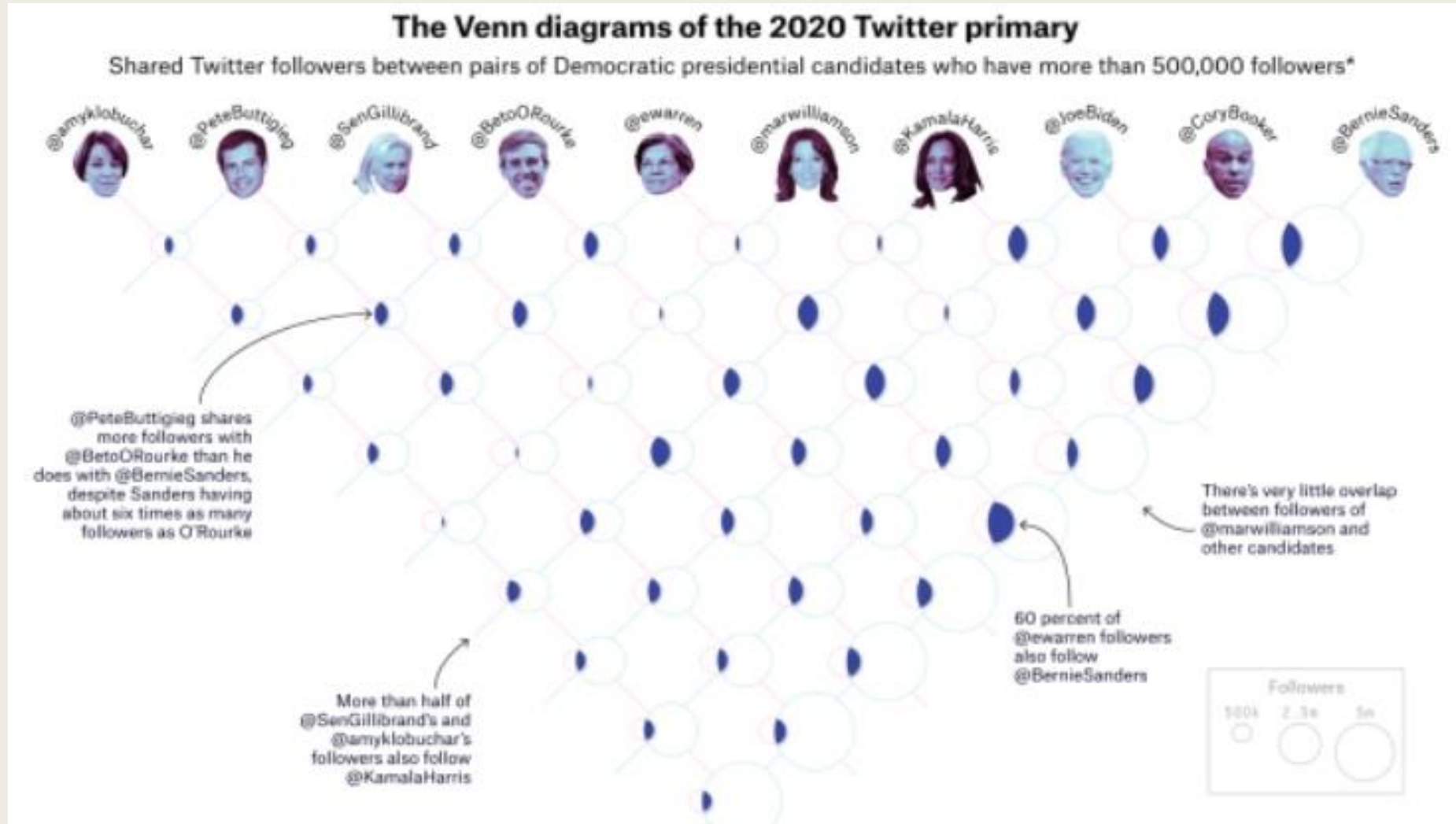
China and US together contribute USD 6.3 trn to world's manufacturing
